

Services Provided

Each VA-Approved CRC Sponsor agrees to provide the Veterans:

- Supervision 24 hours a day
- A comfortable, clean, private, or semi-private room that meets space requirements.
- Three balanced, nutritious meals per day and two snacks
- Weekly laundry service
- Transportation to VA and community appointments, VA programs, outings, and church
- Management of medication administration as prescribed by Veterans VA physician.
- Assistance with daily living skills
- Recreational and socialization activities.

About the Program

The Community Residential Care Program (CRC) provides supervision to eligible Veterans, who are not in need of hospitalization or nursing home placement, but because of medical or mental health conditions, would benefit from living in a CRC setting.

CRC care gives Veterans the opportunity to improve independence and develop social skills in the least restrictive environment.

The VA CRC program staff provide oversight to VA-approved homes/facilities whose staff provide services and support to Veterans enrolled in the program.

The cost to live in the CRC home is privately paid for by the Veteran. The VA CRC program can assist with helping the Veteran understand the rates and resources available to pay for the care.



Community Residential Care Program Provides:

- Case Management
- Care Coordination with VA providers
- Serve as a liaison for the Sponsor and VHA
- Yearly inspections to ensure compliance with VA Standards
- Ongoing sponsor training and education
- Monthly Home Visits

Eligibility

Home/facility sponsors wishing to become VA-approved for the CRC program must complete an application and meet the following criteria:

- Home/facility inspection by VA staff, including a social worker, nurse, dietitian, and safety specialist to ensure the home meets VA requirements.
- VA-approved CRC homes/ facilities must continue to meet VA standards of care and regulations to remain in the program.
